Prior to appointments of Host centres and dates for the 2025 year, an agenda item tabled by Ipswich Hockey to split the U12 Boys and Girls competition was discussed.

- **U12 Competition – boys and girls**

Ipswich Hockey tabled the agenda item to split the U12 competition and have the girls and boys on separate weekends. The reasoning was that the competition was getting larger due to the increase in age to U12s, line up for food and parking was very difficult. With families struggling to watch their sons and daughters playing on the same day. By splitting the

competition to separate weekends would give another centre a chance to host. Ipswich was keen to host the U12 Boys competition.

BWHA stated that there was no room to grow, as this year in 2024 U12, Downey Park utilised all fields and time slots.

BHA stated that it would be good for their boys to visit other centres.

All Associations were in favour of splitting the competition, with BWHA to retain the U12 girls as this is the only competition they can host and the U12 boys be allocated to other centres.

- Socks Rosters: This still seems to be an issue. Pauline did look into the HQld website if the sock roster was available, but this is no longer available on their website. It is only available through altiusrt during competition.

With the ongoing issue with the clash of socks, and at times uniforms, it was agreed that all centres submit their centre's socks combinations and create a sock register for 2025. Once received this will be disseminate to all centres. This way when the draws are announced centres can see the socks worn by all centres to avoid any clashes.

It was also agreed that the team listed first on the draw can wear their primary sock colour, and the 2<sup>nd</sup> team to wear their alternate socks.

If team uniform clashes, it is recommended that all teams bring along bibs to use.

Host Centres to monitor this on the day of competition.
